

WILLIAM BRANHAM:

His teachings 'surface' in Donegal.

For many years now on the first Sunday of January I have given a '**Take Heed**' report in the '**Soldiers of The Cross**' Mission Hall in **Ballinamallard**. Over this past weekend the organiser left a voicemail message for me just to confirm that I shall be there again on 1st January 2017 (DV).

He also asked me if I could comment upon adverts that have appeared in local newspapers in Co Fermanagh encouraging people to listen to messages given by a '**true prophet**' of God. This supposed '**true prophet**' is none other than the late **WILLIAM BRANHAM**.
