Needless to say, my post attracted quite number of comments from fellow Christians who were similarly horrified by what they saw and heard this woman say (I was going to type 'lady' but changed it to 'woman' as I felt that was much more appropriate).

One contributor aptly posted – **Matthew 15:11**. “**Not that which goeth into the mouth defileth a man, but that which cometh out of the mouth, this defileth a man**”.

Later in the chapter the Lord cites examples of those things that “**defile a man**” and included in the list in **verse 19** we find “**blasphemies**”.

In closing, I think it would also be appropriate to quote some of Paul's words found in **Ephesians 5: 1-4** “**Be ye therefore followers of God, as dear children ... But fornication, and all uncleanness or covetousness, let it not be once named among you, as becometh saints; Neither filthiness, nor foolish talking, nor jesting, which are not convenient** (suitable or fitting) but rather giving of thanks”.

Pastor John MacArthur in his Study Bible has this to say about the portions highlighted in red – “**These 3 inappropriate sins of the tongue include any speech that is obscene and degrading and foolish and dirty, as well as suggestive and immoral. All such are destructive of holy living and testimony and should be confessed, forsaken and replaced by open expression of thankfulness to God (cf. Colossians 3:8)**”.

I think those comments are a very succinct summary of what **Jenn Johnson** has done and also of what she needs to do, assuming she truly is a 'born again' believer – something that must now be seriously in question in the light of this 'performance'.
