In some ways this is just an adaptation of aspects of the 'Marches for Jesus' that became 'fashionable' through the 3rd Wave Charismatic Movement of the 1990's and I personally witnessed one such March in Belfast where those participating were told to go out and 'claim the land' rather like Joshua they were told (see Joshua 1:3).

A very helpful book published back in 1993 was **'DO DEMONS RULE YOUR TOWN?'** by Mike R Taylor and if you are concerned by this emergence of 'Prayer Walking' thinking then I would recommend the book.
