"Take Heed" Ministries

Dear praying friends and supporters of 'Take Heed',

I began my June 2022 Ministry Update Letter with details of our ministry relationship with Pastor 'JJ' in Malawi and that friendship continues to strengthen. In September Pastor 'JJ' contacted me to see if 'Take Heed' could possibly fund further copies of the CHICHEWA language versions of 'Dear Muslim Neighbour', 'Purgatory' and 'Jehovah's Witnesses'. As a ministry we were able at that stage to fund a further printing of 10,000 'Dear Muslim Neighbour' booklets, but I explained that the funding of the other requested booklets would have to be put 'on hold' until next year. The September funding brought our overall help for printing in recent years to £5000.00 and the total number of booklets printed in CHICHEWA to 60,000. None of this would have been possible without your generous, sacrificial support, so sincere thanks to all. Please pray that as a ministry we may be able to fund the 'Purgatory' and 'Jehovah's Witnesses' booklets early in 2023 (DV). Following the September funding, Pastor 'JJ' sent the following photos and comments on 6th October —

Just after collecting "Dear Muslim Neighbour" from the printer, in readiness for Mozambique and Zambia distribution in a few weeks to come We have already given out 2000 hard copies to Pastor Janah who is involved in Muslim missions in the Muslim dominated district of Mangochi. Your ministry of 'Take Heed' is a great blessing to us in Malawi, Zambia and Mozambique.






Meanwhile, back here in Northern Ireland I was kept very busy on a number of fronts.

I was privileged to either speak or preach on 28 occasions in churches widely spread over Northern Ireland and also once 'down south'. That was particularly sad and challenging when I was honoured to be asked to speak at the graveside of the wife of a dear friend, **Pastor Keith Malcomson**, of Limerick City Church. His wife, **Candace**, was a truly remarkable and gifted lady in many 'fields' who had bravely battled cancer. We enjoyed happy times in Limerick with them and also on occasions when they came to the Newcastle (Mountains of Mourne) area for some respite. When speaking, I preached on the events surrounding Lazarus recorded for us in John 11 & 12. My headings were (1) The pain of parting (2) The promise of resurrection (3) The prospect of reunion. We look forward to our reunion with Candace in the Lord's presence. Please pray for **Pastor Keith** as he adjusts to life without Candace.

A high percentage of the non-preaching engagements involved either partial or total reference to so-called 'Progressive Christianity' which I referred to on page 4 of my January – June 2022 ministry letter, mentioning in particular a young man called Andrew Cunning who makes repeated claims to being a 'Theologian'. The problem is that he is not a 'Sola Scriptura Theologian' but one who seeks to blend in 'Reason' 'Experience' and 'Tradition' into his 'theological stew' with the result that it ends up being utterly contaminated and poisonous.

In September I was invited by Rev. Bob McEvoy to record an episode for his 'Semper Reformata Podcast' and in particular he wanted me to focus on so-called 'Progressive Christianity'. It was duly broadcast on 8th September with these details

Another 'front' that I was kept busy on was through writing various articles for posting to the 'Take Heed' ministry web site and herewith are details of some of those articles.

'Kingdom Come Conference': Antrim: August 2022. Same 2019 question - whose 'KINGDOM'?

This related to a conference jointly organised by **Journey Community Church** in Antrim and '**Apostle**' Bill Johnson's **Bethel Church** based in **Redding**, California. The same groups organised a similar conference in Belfast in 2019 and this year's programme was drawn up on similar lines and, according to a reliable source, cost around £85,000 to stage. I would be VERY surprised, judging from video I have watched, if the numbers paying and attending had covered that outlay. The involvement and promotion of Ecumenical, New-Age, Dark, Hyper-Charismatic, **Bethel** heresies featured very strongly once more - **not Christ's Kingdom**.

Redeemer Central Church – Belfast Now publicly 'full-on Progressive'

This article (a follow-up from an earlier one written in January 2019) highlighted how this 'church' had 'come-out' publicly as basically being 'full-on Progressive' by an announcement they had made during a service on 20th March 2022. This is a screen-shot of that announcement and really it 'speaks for itself' without any addition needed from me except to quote Matthew 7: 21 "Not everyone that saith unto me, Lord, Lord shall enter into the kingdom of heaven; but he that doeth the will of my Father which is in heaven" and to say that this announcement does not in any way represent our Heavenly Father's will.

Our collective position and posture as a church:

Among the members of our leadership, staff, and community, you'll find a wide spectrum of beliefs about questions related to human sexuality and gender identity, and we believe that agreement on these questions should not be the basis of our unity but the confession of Jesus as Lord by the Spirit is where we centre our unity. We also believe that LGSTQ people have a right to know what they can expect from us in terms of belonging, involvement, leadership, and marriage and the bottom line is that no one at Redwerner Central will be excluded from belonging, involvement, and leadership on the basis of their sexuality or gender identity, and we hope in time that we will have pastors or leaders available to perform weddings for same-sex couples.

REVEREND ERNIE REA: Truly 'Beyond Belief'

Ernie Rea and I attended school together and played many times on the same hockey and cricket teams. For 20 years he presented a BBC religious programme called 'Beyond Belief'. In a 2019 newspaper article Ernie said this when asked about 'hell' – 'If Hell exists, it is empty. A loving God could not condemn one of his children to everlasting fire'. This was one of a number of unbiblical ('Progressive') responses given by Ernie in that article and that I addressed in my article. I phoned Ernie to tell him of my article – the conversation was cordial and friendly so please pray that even now God might truly and savingly enlighten Ernie.

This notice was posted on the Facebook page of the Promenade METHODIST Church, Douglas, Isle of Man.
