On that **SAME LINK** you can now access details of the similarly-named conference due to be held 11th – 14th August 2022 but this time at **Shane's Castle**, Antrim. Once more this event is a partnership between 'Journey Community Church' and the American 'Bethel Church Redding'. This is what **Shane's Castle** and grounds look like –



Judging by the details/descriptions of the speakers and by the hefty costs involved for selected attendance (see details on https://journeycommunity.churchsuite.com/events/fcne9qbn) the overheads (estimated at £85,000+) must be extremely daunting. In addition, much of the programme/schedule contains elements that replicate a lot that took place in Belfast in 2019. That being the case I would encourage a re-reading of what I wrote in 2019 as it explains why I concluded my article in these words

In the title to this article, I posed the question 'But whose Kingdom?'
