Her 'bio' details read as follows –

'Pippa is a full-time missionary with the Catholic Charismatic Renewal and helps lead a worship collective called One Hope Project.'

Any faithful Christian parent should avoid sending their child/children to this event.



I subsequently went to the web site of '**One Hope Project**' located on <https://www.onehopeproject.co.uk/about> and the Home page it states –

One Hope Project's mission is to encourage fresh expressions of worship in the Catholic Church.

I did exchange a few thoughts with someone involved with the event and our exchanges included the following –

Cecil: Sadly I have in times past had to issue warning articles about the make-up of 'Summer Madness' and because of your post I checked out this year's event. Unfortunately when I saw the line up I was again forced to post a warning on my own Facebook site because of the planned presence of PIPPA BAKER who is with the 'CATHOLIC CHARISMATIC RENEWAL' grouping. This is something I could in no way endorse.

Respondee: As you will know, Pippa is one of many people taking part. It's faith backgrounds, and none.

Cecil: it is good that there will be a 'mix of attendees' BUT the fact that they will be exposed to a non-Christian like Pippa means this is a 'tainted' event and one that cuts across (Ephesians 5:11) the clear 'lines of demarcation' that God sets out in His Word. 1 Corinthians 5:7 & 15:33. Zeal is commendable but it must be guided by God's Word.

There would be other worrying aspects and concerns as regards some of the other speakers but I think what I have written here about the **ecumenical involvement of Pippa Baker** serves to demonstrate that no faithful Christian should be involved in promoting this event.
