

# Crusading 'Christian' Political Parties: UKIP and CNP: AVOID!

I think it goes without saying that over recent decades the demographic make-up of the United Kingdom has changed dramatically. One particular group sharing common religious and cultural beliefs and ways has gained great momentum and many see this as a real danger to the centuries old British way of life. **'Nick Marcel Tenconi (born 29 March 1984) is a British politician, personal trainer and activist who has been the leader of the UK Independence Party (UKIP) since February 2025, having served in the interim from June 2024. He is also a COO of the right-wing pressure group Turning Point UK (TPUK) ... According to Searchlight, after Tenconi took leadership of UKIP, he attempted to move closer to controversial activist Tommy Robinson, and appointed anti-Islam activist and preacher Calvin Robinson as its lead spokesperson ... Since becoming leader, Tenconi has made Christian identity politics an important part of UKIP's campaign ... Tenconi has described himself as a "defender of masculinity, Christianity, and conservative values" and has expressed his opposition to what he describes as "satanic woke culture". Based on this, some people have described him and UKIP as Christian nationalist.'**

A recent example of UKIP's leaning towards **ROMAN CATHOLICISM** was when they posted this on Facebook –



On this link <https://www.thechristiannationalistparty.com/leadership> you can see that there is a real mixture of religious 'affiliations' that certainly rule out any notion that this group represents true evangelical Biblical Christianity.
