## **PAUL BARFETT:**

## Worrying aspects of his 'ministry'

Earlier today I received an inquiry asking me if I had heard of a man called **PAUL BARFETT** who had been visiting Northern Ireland in recent days. The following is what I 'uncovered' – some of which I shared in 'skeletal form' with my inquirer but which I have now 'fleshed out' as follows for this post –

"In 1996, 'out of the blue' Margaret and I received an invitation from 'The Lord Chancellor and The Speaker of the House of Commons' to attend the 'National Prayer Breakfast' to be held in the Queen Elizabeth II Conference Centre, Westminster on Wednesday 27th November 1996. However, when I looked at the 'Sponsoring Group' I noted the names of David Alton MP and the Earl of Longford. David Alton, a zealous Roman Catholic, was educated by Jesuits and has travelled worldwide promoting 'views Roman Catholic'. He has authored a number of books including one dealing with Roman Catholic 'pilgrimage' sites in England and Wales. Lord Longford converted to Roman Catholicism in 1940 and his wife similarly converted some 6 years later. Because of this Roman Catholic involvement I quickly realised this would be something I could not possibly attend and so I wrote a short note declining the invitation but in the note I did ask to be kept informed of any other similar events. In a response to my letter, Yvonne Brooks, on behalf of the National Prayer Breakfast wrote "We do not have any other events in London since this is the National annual Breakfast. I understand that there are some smaller events held in different parts of the UK – Rev Paul Symonds would probably know about any held in Ireland".
